

CLEANING PRODUCT RECIPES

Magic Multi-Purpose Cleaner

- 2 oz. Dawn Dish Detergent
- 4 oz. bottled lemon juice
- 8 oz. white vinegar
- 10 oz. water

Pour ingredients into a spray bottle. Spray on surfaces and rinse to clean.

In Shower – to remove soap scum – spray, wait, rinse, and dry if wanted

In Oven – No heat in oven. Spray on surfaces and let sit overnight. Wipe clean with wet microfiber cloths to remove residue.

Mirror Cleaner

Fill small spray bottle with rubbing alcohol. Spray on mirror and clean with wet microfiber cloth. Dry with lint-free microfiber cloth or newspaper.

Soak Cleaner for Oven Hood Filters (No Scrub)

Fill pot (large enough to fit width of filter) with water and bring to a boil. Before boiling, add:

- 1 cup white vinegar
- 1 Tbsp. Dawn blue dish detergent
- ¼-1/2 cup baking soda.

Stir to combine each ingredient. Dip filters into solution for a few minutes. Scrub with a brush if needed to remove stubborn grease. Turn filter to clean other end. Repeat, rinse off. Dry and replace filters into oven hood.

Deck Cleaner

Dissolve ½ cup of Oxygen bleach in 2 gallons of warm water. If large deck, may need more than one batch. Works best on not-too-hot or sunny day, so solution doesn't dry before being rinsed off. Soak deck with water before adding solution, to open pores. Use deck brush to spread solution over deck. May need to scrub to get into grooves. Leave solution on deck for about 10 minutes. Wash off with hose.

N.B. This solution works well on patio furniture, siding, wood or poly-vinyl fencing and most other outdoor surfaces.
